Elexicon Corporation is a holding company, 100 per cent owned by five municipal shareholders: the Town of Whitby, the City of Pickering, the Town of Ajax, the Municipality of Clarington and the City of Belleville. Elexicon Corporation consists of two wholly owned subsidiary operating companies: Elexicon Energy Inc. and Elexicon Group Inc.

Elexicon Energy Inc. is a regulated electricity distribution company that delivers electricity to approximately 175,000 homes and businesses located in ten municipalities in east-central Ontario. The company is regulated by the Ontario Energy Board, an independent regulator of the electricity and natural gas sector. Elexicon Energy, through its investments, is focused on grid modernization and integration of innovative technologies to its distribution network to provide reliable and cost-effective services, to meet the current and future needs of its customers. The company is defining the role of the distributor in the energy transition and electrification of the economy.

Elexicon Group Inc. is an emerging market leader in reducing energy costs and improving sustainability for private and public sector clients. The company believes that the two most powerful ways it can make a difference is by making buildings more energy efficient and accelerating the adoption of electric vehicles ("EVs"). Elexicon Group's Envision Utility Management program uses measurement, data and insights to identify and deliver innovative and best-in-class energy solutions for its clients, including system design, recommissioning and retrofits. The company's joint venture, EVSTART, aims to lead the Canadian market in the implementation of EV charging stations. Elexicon Group relentlessly pursues innovation and challenges the status quo in the pursuit of better bottom lines for its clients.


DIVERSITY, EQUITY AND INCLUSION

All employees and people leaders received DEI training from a DEI Consultant. Elexicon Energy also partnered with a 100 per cent Indigenous owned consultancy group on the development of a Reconciliation Action Plan, and the creation of a Land Acknowledgement and territory map.

ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINABILITY

Winner of the City of Pickering's Sustainability Award



Elexicon Energy was awarded the City of Pickering's Sustainability Award for its work on Altona Towns Pre-Planned Nested Microgrid Community. The new development - Canada's first - demonstrates the future of residential neighbourhoods and shows how microgrids can benefit homeowners while reducing the amount of electricity needed from the grid, helping make the provincial electricity system more affordable. For residents living in the microgrid community, the use of solar panels and battery storage allows them to reduce energy costs by supplying their own power needs. It also provides another option to improve the resiliency of the local electricity grid when faced with extreme weather, providing backup power if there is an outage.

Helping Enable Canada's Net Zero Future and Electrification Strategy



Elexicon Energy is working with technology partner, Survalent, and a handful of other local utilities to enable distributed energy resources such as solar and wind power, energy storage and demand management tools to ensure interoperability between the consumer and the electricity grid. The project will provide a platform that brings together real-time energy supply and consumption information at the local level, and gain a better understanding of how renewable energy sources can be sourced at a local level and contribute to clean, reliable and affordable energy to meet growing needs that include electric vehicles.

Giving Families and Businesses More Control over Electricity Bills



Energy Minister Todd Smith joined Elexicon Energy and several other Ontario energy companies to launch the new Green Button program that will allow families and businesses across the organization's service territory to track and control their energy use and save money on monthly bills. Studies have found that access to energy data, which Green Button along with smart home devices enables, can help consumers achieve energy savings of up to 18 per cent. Ontario becomes the first province in Canada to mandate the standard. Elexicon Energy customers will have access to Green Button by November 2023. Making Energy-Efficient, Low-Carbon Homes More Accessible in Durham Region



Elexicon Energy is participating in a regional household energy retrofit initiative called Durham Greener Homes. Inspired by Durham Region's Community Energy Plan, the program was created to assist homeowners in navigating through the retrofit process to reduce their energy consumption and greenhouse gas emissions. By 2050, the program hopes to remodel the majority of the over 200,000 existing single-family dwellings, including detached, semi-detached and row homes, resulting in an average energy savings of 40 to 50 per cent per household.

Accelerating the Transition to Electric Vehicles

An essential cornerstone of the Corporation's vision and strategy is accelerating the transition to electric vehicles ("EVs"), and in 2022 our subsidiary, Elexicon Group, continued the forward momentum towards delivering on that vision. Through the joint venture with EVSTAR, Elexicon Group installed 218 new EV charging stations across Canada and secured contracts to install 1,000 more in 2023. This is just the start of what promises to be an exponential growth curve towards the full potential of EVs and charging infrastructure in Canada.

Innovative Technologies Promote Sustainability and Cost Savings in our Communities



Elexicon Group led the market in Canada in delivering exciting and innovative technologies to the community.

In September 2022, Elexicon Group installed Realice Cold Water Ice resurfacing at the Uxbridge Arena and Community Centre. Since the installation, there has been a 30 per cent reduction in ice plant electricity usage, along with the elimination of natural gas consumption used for heating the resurfacing water, which translates to approximately \$8,000 a year in savings. In addition, the system improves the ice quality and reduces water usage.

In November 2022, Elexicon Group installed its inaugural motorized pool cover at the Ajax Community Center. Since the installation, there has been a 17 per cent reduction in electricity usage and a substantial 20 per cent reduction in natural gas consumption, meaning tangible cost savings for the facility. The pool cover has also contributed to improving the air quality around the pool deck and has extended the lifespan of the pool dehumidification system, providing additional benefits beyond energy conservation.

With over 3,300 ice rinks and more than 1,000 indoor pools in Canada, these initiatives have the potential to make a substantial contribution to the country's overall greenhouse gas reduction and climate change targets.

Growing the Envision Utility Savings as a Service Program



Elexicon Group's flagship Envision Utility Savings as a Service program has been a great success. The program enables the tracking and analyzing of utility and carbon emission costs and performance using real-time sensors to drive insights, continuous improvement and return on investment for its clients. This initiative continues to grow, and many new clients and hundreds of new buildings have been added to their portfolio.

HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELLNESS

The health, safety and wellness of its employees and the communities it serves are a top priority for Elexicon Corporation and its subsidiaries.

Safety is important to everyone in the organization, and it is critical for Elexicon Energy's front line employees including Line Operations, Metering, and Stations and Protection & Control Automation teams. These employees are highly trained to work efficiently, safely and collaboratively to keep the lights on in homes, workplaces and communities. Their work is dangerous, and they perform it in all types of weather conditions, from the extreme heat to the bitter cold.

On September 28, 2022, Elexicon Energy held its annual Rescue Day, offering these teams valuable refresher training on safe work practices, and the planning and execution of rescues in emergency situations. It was the first time since 2019 the teams from all districts were able to gather due to the pandemic. Training included bucket self-evacuation, bucket rescue, pole top rescue and confined space rescue.

While many companies that adopted a work from home model during the pandemic are requiring employees to return to the office, Elexicon Energy has decided to maintain a hybrid work model for employees whose jobs do not require them to be in the office full time. Employees can come into the office to meet face-to-face with colleagues some days, and work from home other days, maintaining a positive work-life balance.







COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

Community engagement is at the heart of how Elexicon operates. Elexicon's Corporate Giving Program is about empowering the communities it serves to create a better future, together. Last year, the program provided funding to more than 100 community initiatives with a total donation amount of \$349,000.

In 2022, Elexicon created a lasting impact in its communities by:

- Sponsoring not-for-profit events and providing funding through the Corporate Giving Program to organizations and projects that align with Elexicon's mission and vision for the future. Funding is allocated through a formal process based on a Corporate Giving Policy, the proportion of customers within a service area and community need.
- Developing partnerships that contribute to the long-term sustainability of our natural resources, stronger environmental practices and that demonstrate an environment-first mindset to community planning.
- Creating meaningful opportunities for youth and young women in under-represented STEM ("Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics") fields through Elexicon's bursary, scholarship and mentorship programs.

ENVIRONMENTAL INCIDENTS

Climate change has resulted in increased severe weather events, such as extremes in heat, cold, wind, rain, snow and ice, as well as flooding, forest fires and other natural disasters that pose a threat to Elexicon Energy's infrastructure and system reliability. Such weather events also result in more electricity usage during peak periods leading to potential supply issues and compromised or failed distribution assets. In order to mitigate these risks, Elexicon Energy has developed and continues to test its emergency preparedness plans. It is also upgrading distribution assets to better withstand extreme natural events.



REPLACING INFRASTRUCTURE



With the distribution system's aging infrastructure, Elexicon Energy continued to upgrade and replace assets throughout 2022. There is an ongoing maintenance program that includes tree trimming, pole testing, cable injections, switch maintenance and other activities to ensure safe and reliable electricity services. When severe weather has damaged or downed equipment, it has been largely replaced by stronger, more durable assets where possible.
